



## **BAYAN Pacific Northwest Community Self-Defense and Wellness Program**

### **Contract for Outreach Coordinator Position**

**Project Description:** This is a series of self-defense classes focusing on empowerment and self-determination, designed specifically for LGBTQ people and survivors of gender-based violence. This series will focus on communication, boundary-setting and practicing consent, promoting healthy relationships based on trust and respect. There will also be a physical component of building confidence and strength through conditioning and practicing self-defense skills.

**Job Description:** This person will lead an outreach team composed of volunteers and is responsible for implementing the outreach plan for the Community Self-Defense and Wellness Program by Bayan Pacific Northwest. They will be reporting to the Project Coordinator. They will be working an estimated total of 60 hours at the rate of \$16/hr. (\$960 total)

### **Contract Goals/Major Deliverables**

At a minimum, the Outreach Coordinator will bring in 36 total participants in the 30 classes. They will utilize different methods of outreach including:

- Flyering in different neighborhoods, community centers, schools, churches and events
- Contacting various organizations serving LGBTQ, youth, immigrant and refugee and low-income people of color to inform them of our classes through phone and face-to-face meetings.
- Utilizing social media such as Twitter, Facebook, Instagram and Tumblr to spread the word
- Ensuring culturally relevant outreach materials are created, including languages other than English.
